Logline & Synopsis

Logline

The sole journalist of a small town television station guides the audience through a kaleidoscope of local news stories.

Synopsis #1

The film takes a small town television station as the centerpiece of its story and draws a pseudo-ethnographic portrait of a community in Georgia. Rituals and traditions define the lifestyle here, though a distant crooked reflection of the modern world has already invaded the collective mind. Here performance of one's self in the best possible way is of primary importance. This cinematic kaleidoscope of characters, places and events unveils the life of the local community and its hybrid values. The sole journalist of the television station, Dariko, is like Virgil from Dante's 'Divine Comedy', taking the audience on a trip through the community's moments of revelation.

Synopsis #2

Dariko, the only local television journalist in a small town in Georgia, strives from one report to the next to provide a pseudo-ethnographical portrait of a community and its traditions. Like Virgil with Dante, she leads director Salomé Jashi through the Georgian "circles of hell" in a microscopic tragi-comedy that reveals a country in perpetual transition.

Long Synopsis

Flanked by her phlegmatic sidekick, Dariko is the only outside broadcast journalist at a local Georgian television channel. With derisory resources, she races from one report to another to give an honest, if not objective, image of the current events that shape her environment: from the capture of a "giant" owl to the obituaries—where we thus learn that the bearer of the Soviet flag fluttering over the Berlin Reichstag in 1945 has just been buried—passing via the elections. Noticed with Bakhmaro (2011, screened as part of the Focus Georgia, VDR 2015), Salomé Jashi provides, with humour, distance and a consummate sense of framing, a pseudo-ethnographical portrait of a community that, due to modernity and technological miniaturisation, has never ceased to gather material about itself. The multiplication of camera angles (journalist, filmmaker, amateur filmmakers) in The Dazzling Light of Sunset induces a relative competition between images and their distinct depth of focus. She turns the micro-events that punctuate this tragicomedy with absurd overtones into revealing examples of a country that has begun a still chaotic transition.


Director's Note



I started making the film with the idea of a small media organization in my mind – how different its news stories could be from those of the bigger world. It was initially a simple concept and I didn't quite know where it would take me. I chose the municipality of Tsalenjikha for the filming location. As I into research and filming, I became fascinated with how the small stories occurring in the town were slowly constructing a portrait of the community, its frame of mind and constitution. Everything public was either happening on a stage or was related to the idea of stage. Presentation of one's self in the best way possible was of primary importance. This material reflected the way the whole nation functions, where appearance is more valued than content. Georgia is stuck in this notion of a developing country where juxtaposition of old and new blend into a ridiculous fusion. Traditions that the communities nurture are often composed of empty words or automated movements, while the new that is sometimes welcomed is a crooked copy of the contemporary world. In the film the local journalist and TV station were the means to create a mosaic, a hallucinogenic trip into the wonderland.

Salomé Jashi

Biography & Filmography Director



Salomé Jashi was born in Tbilisi, Georgia in 1981. She first studied journalism and worked as a reporter for several years. In 2005 she was awarded a British Council scholarship to study documentary filmmaking at Royal Holloway, University of London. Upon her return to Georgia, together with close friends Salomé founded production company Sakdoc Film. Alongside filmmaking, Salomé was part of Caucadoc, a project that supported the development of the documentary scene in the South Caucasus. She additionally tutors at international workshops.

Salomé's The Dazzling Light of Sunset was awarded the Main Prize at Visions du Réel's Regard Neuf Competition. Her previous film Bakhmaro, made in co-production with ma.ja.de. filmproduktion and MDR/Arte, received an Honorary Mention for a Young Documentary Talent at DOK Leipzig, was awarded as the Best Central and Eastern European Documentary at Jihlava IFF, and was nominated for the Asia Pacific Screen Awards and Silver Eye Awards in 2011. She lives between Tbilisi and Berlin.






