

TAYMETOV. VICTORY FLIGHT

The film tells the story of the first military and civilian pilot in the history of the republic, test pilot, founder of the Uzbek aviation school and the first director of the Tashkent airport, hero of the Second World War Abdusamat Taymetov, who was entrusted with the main secret operation of humanity on the last day of that war, namely, to deliver from Berlin to Moscow the Act of Unconditional Surrender of the German Armed Forces, the Victory Banner and the standards of the defeated Third Reich, which were then burned at the foot of the Kremlin.

The film also tells about the first Uzbek aircraft Li-2, produced at the Tashkent aircraft plant, which became one of the main aircraft at the front and in the rear, its monument stands in the center of the Central Naval Museum "Road of Life", since this aircraft was also the main aircraft during the siege of Leningrad until the appearance of ice on Lake Ladoga. There were ten types of Uzbek aircraft: from a regular passenger plane to a night bomber.

But the first Uzbek pilot and the first Uzbek plane are unfairly forgotten heroes of the war. Taymetov was not awarded the title of hero. No streets or squares were named after him. There are monuments to the T-34 tank or the Katyusha rocket launcher everywhere, but there is no monument to the Uzbek Li-2 aircraft anywhere. Our film is about the heroism of our heroes and how they were unfairly forgotten.
