SYNOPSIS

In how many ways is the environment that surrounds us, capable of influencing our perception of the world around us?

What is the role and main goal of parenting, when they struggle every day to try and let their daughter live a normal life. And above all: what is a normal life?



APPROACH

This short film is neither the first nor the last in which a dream represents the main part of the story.

A dream can be a way in which we run away from reality. However, Sissy doesn't run away from anything when she dreams of flying astride her dog. That's because her reality doesn't exist. How can the audience know, in which way she perceives the environment?

The story moves forward with not even a single line being spoken. The audience need only be focused on the sounds, environment, music and mood.

Why after such a nice long day does Sissy dream of flying? Probably, it's only a matter of perception.



In 2012 he wrote and directed the documentary "How to become a Serial Killer", in collaboration with the video production company *On air communication s.r.l.*

In 2014, he founded his own video production company, the *Barn Owl s.a.s.*, thanks to which he began to realize his first commercials. Due to his skills and creativity his portfolio comprises of works which have been bought by blue chip companies such as Lufthansa, Beck's Beer, Fernet-Branca and Canon.

Currently, he lives in the UK, which he has recently moved to, in order to take-on new challenges.
