SYNOPSIS

'Miami Love Affair' follows three relationships as they sail through the highs and lows of the biggest international art fair in Miami. Our protagonists will (re-) discover their true passions and inspirations, their relationship to the monetary aspect of art, and maybe find love in the process.

When Lucia, a talented artist from Latin America, meets Benedict, an arrogant German artist, sparks of disagreement fly immediately, although they have to share an exhibition.

Victor, an aspiring writer, travels to Miami with his girlfriend Anna, assistant to Robert, a wealthy art dealer. Anna is more in love with money and her job than Victor, so he begins to spend time with the adventurous free-spirit Nina.

Theo, Nina's boyfriend, paid for his first exhibition in Miami and is trying to 'make it big'. With the help of a 'PR Master' he successfully woes a rich old lady, owner of a Hotel chain, to commission hundreds of paintings. However, nothing is ever as easy as it seems: the older lady wants sex in return. Remorsefully he returns to Nina who by now has decided to dump him for Victor, unaware that she is repeating the pattern of supporting an upcoming artist, instead of making her own artistic pursuits a priority.

The Latin Lucia and the German Benedict finally connect through their creativity. They overcome cultural miscommunications and are swept away by the Latin flair of Miami.

If you can succeed in Miami, find love and not get sucked in by the greed and tempting song of Mamon, the God of money – it is THE place to be.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT



Miami needs a new movie to showcase the changes and growth in this international melting pot. I always felt that there is more to Miami then 'Bikinis and Beaches' - the tourist version of this city, and we want to share what life here really has to offer (and why we choose to live here).

Since 2008 new trendy areas such as Wynwood and Midtown are making Miami a hot spot for artists, start-ups and Millennials. Miami is the Capital of South America, the new 'United Nations for the Rich'.

It is a paradisiac city to live in, with sunny weather, great international cuisine and an active nightlife. And there is Art Basel, the biggest art fair in the Western World attracting millions of visitors every December.

But with all the art, there is also an influx of money corrupting this artistic development, which I chose as an underlying Leitmotiv for our film: Does all the glamour entice our artists to sell out and give in to their greed?

The movie is a homage to Miami, a romantic comedy that makes viewers experience a struggle for greatness in the exciting world of art while following the never-ending quest for true love. The resulting 'Miami Love Affair' materializes with a double meeting: A growing love for the city and an actual love affair promising a new beginning while threatening our characters' existing relationships.

Ralph Kinnard is an award-winning actor's director, with extensive work experience in three different countries and their cultures: Germany, the USA, and Venezuela.

His latest feature, "A MI ME GUSTA," participated in 12 international festivals and received several award nominations, winning three as "Best Director" (L.A. Arpa Film Festival, NYC SF Festival, and Mexico International Film Festival).

Highlights of his career include working for Woody Allen ("Celebrities") and BBC of London. A job opportunity through international Latin soap icon Mimi Lazo changed his course to Venezuela, where he worked for several major Latin networks, such as E! Entertainment, Venevision, and RCTV, among others.

In 2009, he created the Miami Acting Studio. This workspace has quickly become Miami's premier professional resource center giving local actors a tool to showcase their talent in a professional setting.

Ivan Oms Blanco has been Director of Photography since 1991, known among others for his prized films 'Adiós madres' (Goodbye Mothers - 2007) selected for an Academy Award in the Foreign Language category, 'Malak' (2011) winning Opera Prima Award in the Tangier Festival, "Adiós Carmen" (Goodbye Carmen) (2012) winning Special Jury Prize at the Dubai Festival 2013.

His expertise as Cinematographer is based on his 24 years of work in Europe as well as in several countries of Africa and Latin America. He holds the Director of Photography credit, for the show "Master Chef Maroc" for MedPro and SHINE France.

Julian Fernau, originally from Germany, is a business professional with more than ten years of experience in the world of corporate finance and sales.

After graduating the top ranked European Business School, Germany, he started a successful career at Procter & Gamble and completed multiple assignments across different categories and areas of financial management based out of Geneva, Switzerland.

Mónica Pasqualotto is a widely acclaimed TV Show, Radio Hostess and Actress from Venezuela, having had own daily programs on Venezuelan and US Hispanic TV for over ten years.

She won national awards as best actress for TV Soaps as well as her performance in A MI ME GUSTA in 2009.

Her work as a producer is spread from TV Shows like "Que bien te ves (1999)", to her Radio Show of over 8 years in Planeta (105.3FM) to shorts like "Ausente" (2006), which was also selected to the L.A. SHORT FILM FESTIVAL.

She is spokesperson and public figure for NIKE, RED BULL and PEUGOT.

Monica has started her artistic career at an early age. She had produced her own CD as a singer even before finishing her Studies at the University of Andrés Bello in Social Communications in 1999.

Since 2010 she has been working with Social Media, with her own Youtube Show and by now more than a million followers across social media platforms.



Aniela McGuinnes Nolita

Aniela McGuinness started her career behind the scenes but always knew that she belonged on the other side. With a technical theater degree from Florida State University, she became the carpentry assistant and electric assistant the James L. Knight Center and very quickly got offered a contract as a production props person for Florida Grand Opera. She became an ensemble cast member of the longest running improvisational comedy troupe in Miami "Laughing Gas" during her summers off and finally decided to follow her dream full-time in the summer of 2009.

She soon landed a national SAG campaign for Home Depot, then a role on a Spanish Sitcom on Univision as the kooky bilingual neighbor. Immediately after she was cast as a waitress in the blockbuster film "Rock of Ages", starring Tom Cruise. She has been a co-star on Burn Notice and Charlie's Angels, not to mention the lead in many indie short films.
